

Year 2 Curriculum Overview: Autumn Term 2021

Creative Curriculum: This term we are exploring the Polar Regions. In geography we will be focusing on the countries within the Arctic Circle. We will learn how to locate these on the globe and their national flags. In Term 2 which has a history focus we will be learning key events that happened during the Fire of London and understand the events that happened in London that cause us to celebrate Bonfire Night today.

<u>PE:</u> PE kit consists of: black shorts, white t-shirt, jagging bottoms, jumper and trainers. Can your child wear their P.E. kit to school every Manday and Thursday?

Science: In Term I we will be learning to work scientifically performing simple experiments and recording them. We will be asking questions and discovering whether some changes are reversible or irreversible. Term 2- We will be finding out about Materials, thinking about how we use them and what we use them for. We also examine the properties of these materials.
